We are very excited about the Women's Seminar this year and we hope you can join us. Our theme is, "The Rapture" taken from 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18 as shown on page 1. Below is a footnote about these verses.

It is the Lord Jesus Himself who will return. Shout is a military term used for ordering troops to assemble. This shout calls the dead to life. The voice of an archangel and the trumpet emphasize the divine authority and the victory of this command. Christians already dead will rise before those still alive. Shall be caught up: The word *rapture* comes from the Latin translation of this phrase. Throughout Scripture clouds are representative of the divine glory (see Acts 1:9). Knowing that Christians who had already died would also be in the resurrection gave comfort—added strength—to those who were suffering persecution as well as bereavement. (1 Thessalonians 4:16-18)

In the book titled "The Great Disappearance" by Dr. David Jeremiah, he says this about the Rapture:

So there's a bright light on the horizon, and we have plenty of evidence. It's going to be the greatest of all great days—the best day of your life. A Great Day of hope, homecoming, healing, happiness, and holiness. It's going to be a Great Day with Him who is preparing at this very moment to return in the skies *above* us and *for* us.

Jesus said: "In My Father's house are many mansions; if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also." (John 14:2-3) Highlight those words, "I will come again and receive you to Myself." That's Rapture talk. During one of the most comforting messages Jesus ever gave His followers, including us, the Rapture was at the forefront of His mind.

Our objective as Christians is not merely to be included in the Rapture but to take as many people with us as we can.
