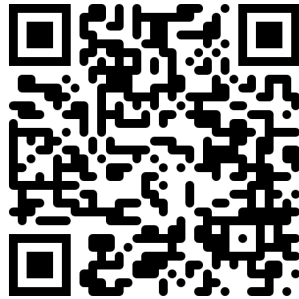


Women's One Day Seminar

Skyler Marie Derrington was born on February 2, 2013 in Houston, Texas to Joe and Lacey Derrington. In the summer of 2022, at the age of 9, Skyler attended Camp Mystic for the first time. During her 4th summer there, she survived the July 4, 2025 central Texas flood. Her cabin, Bug House, was the closest to the Guadalupe River. Skyler became more than just a survivor, she became an overcomer. Her faith in Christ led her to rewrite the lyrics of Leonard Cohen's "Hallelujah" as remembrance to the lives lost on that day. Her heartfelt tribute to her Camp Mystic tribe went viral. Shortly thereafter, she was invited to tell her story, and sing her song on Fox and Friends in New York City where she was surprised by Lauren Daigle. Later in November of 2025, Skyler was the youngest person to ever receive a Fox Patriot Award in the new category of "Faith." Today Skyler is in Junior High School. She maintains A's and B's in upper level classes. She is in choir, cheerleading, basketball, and track. She continues to take singing lessons, write new songs, and inspire others with her love for Jesus. God is still writing her story...
